

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 55-73

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Sanford Throssell, hereinafter referred to as "permittees", members of the Papago Tribe on the Sells Reservation, have applied for a trader's permit to open and operate a western store upon trust lands assigned to them and located in the Sells District, and

WHEREAS, the Sells District Council, at a special meeting held on the 31st day of August, 1973, did approve the granting of such permit, and referred the application to the Papago Tribal Council.


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby grant to Mr. and Mrs. Sanford Throssell, members of the Papago Tribe, a trader's permit to open and operate a western store upon trust lands assigned to them and located in the Sells District, upon the following terms and conditions:

1. the permit hereby granted shall not be assigned without first obtaining this Council's consent for such assignment;
2. the term of the permit is for a period of three years from this date, the permittees to have the option to renew the permit for an additional two years thereafter provided they have fully complied with the terms of the permit;
3. the permit is subject to the payment of the standard sales tax imposed from time to time by the Papago Tribal Council; and
4. the permit does not expand permittees' interest in the trust lands assigned to them, which lands shall remain subject to the reservation in the Papago Tribe of all mineral rights and/or income therein or to be derived therefrom.


The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on Sept. 24, 1973, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 20 for, 0 against, and 2 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(c) and Section 3(a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
