

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 66-73

WHEREAS, at a special meeting of the District Council of the Schuk Toak District held on December 2, 1973, it was unanimously resolved to remove Raymond Marcho as District delegate to the Papago Council, and


WHEREAS, Frank Romero, the alternate District delegate to the Papago Council had previously died, and

WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council unanimously selected Frank Pablo to complete the term of Raymond Marcho on the Papago Council until election time in accordance with Section 19 of Ordinance No. 45 of the Papago Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Papago Council does hereby accept the selection of Frank Pablo as District delegate to the Papago Council in the place of, and to complete the term of Raymond Marcho until the next election.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the seventh day of December, 1973, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of fourteen for, one against, seven not voting, and zero absent, pursuant to authority contained in Article III of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as on the date of approval by the Papago Agency Superintendent and is not subject to review by the Secretary.



On December 2, 1943 the District Council of Schuk Toak District met for a special meeting to discuss the position of Raymond Narcho as Papago Councilman.

For several meetings Ray didn't ~~give~~ come to give report from the Tribal Council Mtg. It was also stated that Ray was never on time at the Tribal Council meetings.

Therefore the District Council feel it is necessary to remove Raymond Narcho from office and have Frank Pablo to complete the term to the election time.

Ray's alternate was the late Frank Romero who died two months ago.

The Council voted 7 in favor
