

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 6-73

WHEREAS Mr. John Griffin, Editor of the Indian Tribal Series of Phoenix, wishes to mint a commemorative silver medal and book dedicated to the Papago Tribe of Arizona; and

WHEREAS the story of the Papago people and their history of the past and aspirations for the future will thereby receive wide national distribution; and

WHEREAS all the text of the book will be reviewed by the Tribal Administration and the Papago Council before it is published;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Mr. John Griffin of Indian Tribal Series be authorized to proceed with the Papago portion of the medallion series.

The foregoing resolution was enacted by the Papago Council on February 23, 1973, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 20 for; 0 against; 2 absent; 0 not voting, pursuant to authority contained in Article V, Section 2(1) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as on the date of approval by the Papago Agency Superintendent and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
