WHEREAS, Edward J. Encinas, District Representative to the Papago Council from the San Xavier District, because of press of business, has tendered his resignation (copy attached) from the Papago Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Papago Council accepts with regret the resignation from the Papago Council of Edward J. Encinas as Councilman from the San Xavier District.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the seventh day of December, 1973, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of twenty for, zero against, zero not voting, and two absent, pursuant to authority contained in Article III of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as on the date of approval by the Papago Agency Superintendent and is not subject to review by the Secretary.

- 1.
