

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 18-74

WHEREAS, The Papago Council is deeply interested in the well being of the Papago people, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been informed of a (On the job training program) provided by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, There is a need for such training in the Construction Department, and the Papago Tribal Utility Authority, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council feels there is a need for such a program in the two departments mentioned above.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, The Papago Council hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Papago Council to carry out the necessary arrangements.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 5th, 1974, at a meeting of which a quorum was present by a vote of 20 for and 0 against, 2 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2(d), Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, and is not subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
