

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 20-74

WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District of the Papago Tribe has requested an increase in the District Budget for Fiscal Year 1974 in the amount of \$218,111.00 to cover anticipated expenditures in the last four months of the fiscal year making a total budget for 1974 of \$692,540.00, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been appraised that the Sif Oidak District has received funds from 1969 to 1974 of \$3,220,556.58 and expended \$2,412,662.87 with present balance in the Treasury of \$807,893.71, there is sufficient balance in the U. S. Treasury to meet this need.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Sif Oidak District budget with the increase included in Fiscal Year 1974 is approved in the amount of \$692,540.00.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on May 3rd 1974, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, 4 not voting and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 3(a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
