

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No 4-74

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe requested a grant from the Economic Development Administration, EDA, to construct a Commodity Warehouse on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, EDA awarded a grant (Number 07-11-0130) in the amount of \$104,000 for the construction of the commodity warehouse and

WHEREAS, the construction of the warehouse is complete and is presently being used by the Food Distribution Division, and

WHEREAS, the manager of the Food Distribution Division has expressed his approval and satisfaction with the warehouse facility, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council therefore desires to accept and acknowledge approval of the Commodity Warehouse.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE PAPAGO COUNCIL hereby accepts and approves the Commodity Warehouse.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st day of January, 1974 with a vote of 21 for, 0 against, 0 not voting, and 1 absent, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Sections 2 (d) and (f) and 3 (a) and (h) of the Constituion and By Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 21, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
