

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 15-75

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on March 14, 1975, adopt a Uniform Election
2 Ordinance in accordance with Section 5 of Article III of the Papago
3 Constitution, as amended; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did, by Resolution No. 9-75, set the general
5 election on May 5, 1975, and appointed the Papago Election Board
6 to supervise the elections; and

7 WHEREAS, the time schedule provided in the Uniform Election Ordinance might
8 in this election make an undue hardship on certain voters unless
9 special relief is granted; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tribal budget makes no provision for payment of authorized per
11 diem and mileage expenses, and of necessary staff and other expenses
12 of the Papago Election Board.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, for the 1975 general election only, the
14 time allowed in Section I of Article II of the Uniform Election
15 Ordinance for voters to register is continued to and including April
16 24, 1975;

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the existing budget of the Papago Enrollment
18 Committee be increased by FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) and that
19 per diem and mileage expenses of the Papago and District Election
20 Boards authorized by Resolution No. 9-75, and the necessary staff
21 time and other expenses of the Election Board, such as printing of
22 ballots, be charged to the existing budget of the Papago Enrollment
23 Committee.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
25 day of April, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
26 18 for, 0 against, 2 not voting and 2 absent pursuant to authority vested in
27 the Papago Council by Sec. 3(a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws
28 of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936
29 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat: 984)
30 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effec-
31 tive as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency
32 and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
