RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 18-75

1 WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Agriculture has filed claim against the Papago
2 Tribe for recovery of FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE DOLLARS
3 (\$5,129.00) for unidentified inventory losses from the Papago Distri-
4 bution Program in Fiscal Year 1973; and

5 WHEREAS, USDA has cooperated in reducing this claim as far as possible but is
6 now pressing for payment; and


7 WHEREAS, as the Council did review this claim on September 6, 1974 and did
8 suggest additional appeals which have been refused; and

9 WHEREAS, the Program is important to the Papago people.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Papago Council on recommendation of the
11 Tribal Treasurer and Program Directors does hereby authorize a budget
12 modification to permit payment of this claim in three (3) equal parts
13 at the discretion of the Treasurer.


14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th day
15 of April, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 18
16 for, 0 against and 4 not voting and passed, pursuant to the authority vested in
17 the Papago Council of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12,
18 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat:
19 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is
20 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
21 Agency and is ~~not~~ subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
