RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 20-75

1 WHEREAS, it is necessary to employ the services of an architectural firm to
2 assist the Papago Housing Authority in the preparation and execution
3 of documents necessary to obtain HUD approval for, and funding of
4 Housing units under HUD's low Rent Public Housing Program and to
5 provide architectural and engineering services for such project; and

6 WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Papago Housing Authority that the firm
7 of Lescher and Mahoney, Architects and Engineers, of Phoenix, Arizona,
8 be retained for such services; and


9 WHEREAS, Lescher and Mahoney by letter agreement to the Papago Housing Authority
10 dated March 24, 1975, have agreed to perform preliminary services and
11 to assist in the execution of all documents necessary to obtain appro-
12 val and funding from HUD for such project, with the understanding that
13 Lescher and Mahoney will be hired as design architects for the project,
14 based on standard HUD fees and contract form, if and when the project
15 is approved.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the firm of Lescher
17 and Mahoney is hereby retained to perform the necessary preliminary
18 services and to assist the Papago Housing Authority in the execution
19 of all documents necessary to obtain approval and financing from HUD
20 for its proposed housing project, with the understanding that the
21 services of Lescher and Mahoney may be cancelled by the Papago Housing
22 Authority without obligation at any time prior to HUD's final approval
23 and with the further understanding that, upon receipt of such approval
24 Lescher and Mahoney will be hired as design architects for the pro-
25 ject, based on standard HUD fees and contract form, in accordance
26 with its letter agreement dated March 24, 1975, to the Papago Housing
27 Authority.


28 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th day
29 of April, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 20
30 for, 0 against, 2 not voting and 0 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the
31 Papago Council by Sec. 2(a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the
32 Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and


1 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat: 984)
2 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effect-
3 ive as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency
4 and is ^{not} subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
