

1 WHEREAS; a primary election was held on April 26, 1975, in accor-
2 dance with the Uniform Election Ordinance for the pur-
3 pose of selecting two candidates to run in the general
4 election scheduled on May 24, 1975, for the offices of
5 Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Papago Council, and

6 WHEREAS; the Papago Election Board did on April 26, 1975, issue
7 its Certificate of Election Results, which Certificate
8 was posted as required in the Uniform Election Ordinance
9 and certifies that the following two candidates for the
10 offices of Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Papago
11 Council received the highest number of votes for their
12 respective offices, to-wit:

13 1) for Chairman: Cipriano Manuel
14 Cecil Williams

15 2) for Vice-Chairman Enos J. Francisco, Jr.
16 Max H. Norris

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby
18 authorize and direct the Chairman and Secretary of the
19 Papago Council to issue, a Certificate of Election on
20 behalf of the Papago Council to the following persons,
21 to-wit:

22 1) As candidates for the office of Chairman of the
23 Papago Council, subject to the general election:

24 Cipriano Manuel
25 Cecil Williams

26 2) As candidates for the office of Vice-Chairman of
27 the Papago Council, subject to the general elec-
28 tion:

29 Enos J. Francisco, Jr.
30 Max H. Norris

31 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
32 the 29th day of April, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was
present with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, 0 not voting and 4 ab-
sent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council con-
tained in Article III and Sec. (f) of the Constitution and By-laws
of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December
12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January
6, 1937 (48 Stat: 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its
