

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 25-75

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on April 7, 1975, by Resolution
2 No. 15-75, increase the budget of the Papago Enrollment
3 Committee by FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) so as to
4 enable the Papago and District Election Boards to charge
5 the per diem and mileage expenses authorized under Res-
6 olution No. 9-75, and necessary staff time and other
7 expenses (such as printing of ballots) of the Election
8 Board to the existing budget of the Papago Enrollment
9 Committee; and

10 WHEREAS the election Board has completed supervision of the pri-
11 mary election and it appears that the cost of completing
12 and supervising the elections will exceed the amount
13 originally estimated and set.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the existing budget of the
15 Papago Enrollment Committee be increased by an additional
16 FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00), or by a total of TEN
17 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) and that all per diem and
18 mileage expenses of the Papago and District Election
19 Boards authorized under Resolution No. 9-75, and the
20 necessary staff time and other expenses of the Election
21 Board, such as printing of ballots, be charged to the
22 existing increased budget of the Papago Enrollment Com-
23 mittee in accordance with the attached budgetary estimate.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
25 the 2nd day of May, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was pre-
26 sent with a vote of 21 for, 0 against, 0 not voting and 1 absent,
27 pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council contained in
28 Article V, Section 3(a) of the Constitution and By-laws of the
29 Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936,
and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937
(48 Stat: 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the
Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by
the Secretary of the Interior.


