1	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council did on March 11, 1975, enact the Uniform Election
2		Ordinance; and
3	WHEREAS,	Article V of the Election Ordinance provides for a form of ballot for
4		the general election which is different from the ballot traditionally
5		used in past elections; and
6	WHEREAS,	most of the District and Village Councils have experienced difficult-
7		ies in meeting the Ordinance's timetable and have expressed a prefer-
8		ence to use the traditional color-coded ballots and voting procedures
9		for this general election; and
10	WHEREAS,	it is the recommendation of the Papago Election Board that for this
11		general election, the traditional color-coded ballots and posters be
12	ļ.	used in the general election scheduled for May 24, 1975, for the
13		offices of Representatives to the Papago and District Councils in all
14	1	Districts, except those which have indicated a preference to have their
15		candidates identified by pictures.
16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that for the general elec-		
17		tion scheduled for May 24, 1975, the ballot requirements of the Uni-
18		form Election Ordinance be waived and that the traditional color-coded
19		ballots and posters be used in the elections for the offices of Repre-
20		sentatives to the Papago and District Councils in all District except
21		those which have indicated a preference to have their candidates iden-
22		ified by pictures.
23	BE IT FUR	THER RESOLVED that the District Election Boards of the various Districts
24		are charged with completing the color-coded ballots by marking the
25		names of the Villages and District on the top of each ballot given to
26		each prospective voter, and by marking thereon the number of candidates
27		such voter is permitted to vote for upon such ballot; and that the
28		District Election Boards are further charged with completing and post-
29		ing the traditional color-coded election posters in such a way that
30		each voter can make easy reference to such posters showing the names
31		of the District or Village Council to which the candidates are seeking
32		election, and the names and (if the proper pictures are provided by

the candidates) the pictures of such candidates.
