

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 29-75

1 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 13-75, the Papago Council appointed Betsy Norris,
2 Christine K. Johnson and Juanita Scott as alternates to take the place
3 on the Papago Election Board of members of such Board who are or be-
4 come candidates for elective office; and

5 WHEREAS, Christine K. Johnson has herself become a candidate for elective office
6 and another alternate needs to be appointed to serve on the Papago
7 Election Board.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Carmalita Patricio,
9 a staff employee of the Papago Enrollment Department, is hereby appoint-
10 ed as an alternate member of the Election Board to fill the unexpired
11 term of any previously appointed member of such Board who has become
12 a candidate for elective office.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th day
14 of May, 1975, at a meeting at whcch a quorum was present with a vote of 21 for,
15 0 against, 0 not voting and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papa-
16 go Council by Section 6 of Article III, as amended, and by Section 2(e), (f)
17 and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
18 Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-
19 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
20 June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by
21 the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the
22 Secretary of the Interior.
