

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 36-75

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe did on Saturday May 24, 1975, have a
2 General Election for the offices of Chairman and Vice-
3 Chairman of, and Representatives and Alternates to, the
4 Papago Council, and for the offices of Representatives
5 and Alternates to the District Councils; and
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Election Board did issue and post its Certi-
7 ficates of Election Results in accordance with Section
8 3(J) of Article V of the Uniform Election Ordinance,
9 certifying to the election of the candidates who re-
10 ceived the highest number of votes for elective office;
11 and
12 WHEREAS, under Section 3(M) of Article V of the Uniform Election
13 Ordinance, it is incumbent upon the Papago Council to
14 issue Certificates of Election to the candidates who re-
15 ceived the highest number of votes for elective offices
16 on the Papago Council within ten (10) days after the
17 Election Board has posted its Certificates of Election
18 Results unless an election contest statement is filed
19 within the time allowed.
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the
21 Chairman and Secretary of the Papago Council are hereby
22 authorized and directed on behalf of the Papago Council
23 to execute and deliver a Certificate of Election to those
24 persons certified by the Papago Election Board as having
25 received the highest number of votes for the offices of
26 Chairman and Vice-Chairman, and Representatives and Al-
27 ternates to, the Papago Council.
28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such Certificates of Election shall be
29 issued as soon as permitted under Section 3(M) of Article
30 V of the Uniform Election Ordinance to such persons
31 against whom no election contest statment has been filed
32 as provided in the Uniform Election Ordinance.

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5 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
6 the 28th day of May, 1975; at a meeting at which a quorum was pre-
7 sent with a vote of 20 for, 0 against, 1 not voting and 1 absent;
8 pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 5 of
9 Article III and of Section 2(f) of Article V of the Constitution
10 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe
11 on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
12 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
13 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval
14 by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to
15 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
