

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona applied for and received a
2 grant from the U.S. Economic Development Administration
3 for the construction fo a multi-purpose communtiy building
4 at San Xavier and other locations identified as EDA
5 Project No. 07-01-00496, and

6 WHEREAS, the construction of these buildings was awarded to the
7 Papago Construction Company under a Force Account Agree-
8 ment, and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Construction Company has satisfactorily completed
10 the consturction of a mulit-purpose community building
11 at San Xavier which has been inspected and approved by
12 the Papago Construction Company and the Project Archi-
13 tect, Joe Wong of Wong Associated, Scottsdale, Arizona.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council, be this
15 Resolution, accept the building as complete.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council extend its appre-
17 ciation and gratitude to the Economic Development Admin-
18 istration for the grant that made the construction of
19 this needed facility possible.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
21 the 23rd day of July, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was
22 present with a vote of 834.0 for, 0 against, 0 not voting,
23 and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council
24 by Section 2(d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the
25 Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936
26 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
27 pursuant to Section 12 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution
28 is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent
29 of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary
30 of the Interior.
