RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Livestock Complex Additions)

RES. NO. 48-75

1 WHEREAS, the well being and success of the Papago Livestock
2 industry will be aided with a centralized livestock
3 complex facility, and
4 WHEREAS, the U. S. Economic Development Administration has approved
5 grant funds for the construction fo a Papago Livestock
6 Complex, and
7 WHEREAS, the original grant of SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE THOUSAND
8 DOLLARS (\$663,000) for construction has been increased
9 to EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$861,000)
10 through amendments to the original grant by the E.D.A.
11 which includes ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS
12 (\$139,000) of new construction including the addition
13 of Alternate No. 1 (Corrals to the south of the site),
14 two hay sheds, horse stalls, blacksmith shop, lengthening
15 hay racks, and paving, and
16 WHEREAS, the architect engineer has prepared appropriate plans
17 and specification for these additions.
18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby
19 authorized the Tribal Chairman to review and accept such
20 plans and specifications for the authorized additions to
21 the Livestock Complex.
22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
23 the 23rd day of July, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was
24 present with a vote of 834.0 for, 0 against, 0 not voting,
25 and 0 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council
26 by Section 2(d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the
27 Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936,
28 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
29 pursuant to Section 12 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution
30 is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent
31 of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary
32 of the Interior.
