RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 49-75

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has as one of its objectives, the main-
2 tenance of the good health of its people; and
3 WHEREAS, tribal personnel from all progrmas (as well as the health
4 programs) come into direct contact with Tribal members
5 when they provide services; and
6 WHEREAS, the Tribal health policy and advisory bodies (the Excutive
7 Health Staff and the Papago Community Health Policy Group),
8 as well as the Indian Health Service physicians recommend
9 that routine annual physical examinations be made manatory
10 for all Tribal employees,
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that annual
12 physical examinations be mandatory for all Tribal employees
13 effective immediately. The Papago Council confers upon
14 the responsibility of setting and maintaining the standards
15 and policies relating to employee physicals.
16 The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
17 the 24th day of July, 1975, by a vote of 834.0 for, 0 against,
18 0 not voting and 0 absent, during a meeting at which a
19 quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago
20 Council by Article V. Section 2 (a), (e), (f), and (h), Section 3
21 (a) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
22 ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the
23 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984)
24 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution
25 is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent
26 of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary
27 of the Interior.
