

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES, NO. 51-75


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Housing Authority is named defendant in a  
2 suit filed in the United States District Court of Arizona  
3 (CIV 75-100 TUC) by Vernon Smith, et al., against Gila  
4 River Construction, Inc., et al., alleging violation of the  
5 Davis Bacon Act, the Fair Labor Standard Act, the Civil  
6 Rights Act, and of contractual rights in the employment  
7 practices of Gila River Construction, Inc.; and  
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Housing Authority is named as such defendant  
9 upon the allegation that it holds certain funds which may  
10 be payable to the principal defendant, Gila River Construc-  
11 tion, Inc., and  
12 WHEREAS, the U.S. Secretary of Labor and the Secretary of the Depart-  
13 ment of Housing and Urban Development are named co-defend-  
14 ants in said suit; and  
15 WHEREAS, there appears to be no conflict to interest between the  
16 Papago Housing Authority and the United States of America  
17 in the defense of this action; and  
18 WHEREAS, it would be to the benefit of the Papago Tribe if the  
19 Papago Housing Authority were represented by the United  
20 States Attorney in the defense of this action.  
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Papago Council that it does  
22 hereby request the United States Attorney to represent  
23 the Papago Housing Authority in all legal proceedings  
24 involved in connection with Civil Cause of Action No. 75-  
25 100 TUC. on file in the United States District Court of  
26 Arizona, and does hereby authorize Cecil Williams, Chairman  
27 of the Papago Council, to execute any and all consents  
28 or other instruments necessary for substitution of counsel,  
29 or otherwise, in order to facilitate the purposes of this  
30 Resolution.  
31 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council  
32 on the 24th day of July, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum

1 was present with a vote of 770.5 for, 0 against, 63.5 not voting,  
2 and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council  
3 by Section 2 (a), (b) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and  
4 By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on  
5 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior  
6 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
7 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval  
8 by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to  
9 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
