

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 53-75

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has appointed a Committee for Allocation
2 of Mining Income to study and report back to the Council
3 its recommendations on the use and division of Tribal
4 mining income; and

5 WHEREAS, said Committee has had various meetings, and anticipates
6 the need for future meetings; and

7 WHEREAS, at the time it authorized and appointed the Committee, the
8 Papago Council failed to authorize or set per diem and
9 mileage expense allowances for members of the Committee,

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Committee
11 for Allocation of Mining Income shall be entitled to receive
12 upon presentation of proper vouchers, per diem payments of
13 \$40.00 per day, or portions thereof, they attend meetings,
14 plus \$.12 per mile traveled to Committee meetings or while
15 on Committee Business.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer of the Papago Council
17 establish a separate budget for the Committee for Alloca-
18 tion of Mining Income in the amount of \$ _____
19 for the balance of this fiscal year against which the per
20 diem of mileage allowances to the Committee members shall
21 be charged.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
23 the 24th day of July, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was
24 present with a vote of 661.0 for, 141.0 against, 32.0 not voting,
25 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by
26 Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the
27 Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936,
28 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937
29 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
30 Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the
31 Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the
32 Secretary of the Interior.
