8	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council has been informed that 16 western States propose t				
9		file amicus curiae briefs in support of the State of Colorado and of				
10		its interpretation that the McCarren Amendment gives the State courts				
11		exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate all water rights claims within				
12		each State's geographical boundaries; and				
13	WHEREAS,	the position of such States and their interpretation of the McCarren				
14		Amendment is diametrically opposed to that of the Papago Tribs as				
15		pleaded in the case of The Papago Indian Tribe v. Pima Mining Company				
16		et al., (U.S. District Court of Arizona-Civ. 75-51 Tuc-JAW); and				
17	WHEREAS,	an adverse construction by the U. S. Supreme Court in the case of				
18		United States v. Akin, would adversely affect the suit of the Papago				
19	e e	Tribe against the water users adjacent to the San Xavier Reservation;

21	WHEREAS,	the Native American Rights Fund proposes to file an amicus curiae				
22		brief in the Akin case on behalf of the National Tribal Chairman's				
23		Association and the Southern Ute Tribe,				
24	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize				
25		and request the Native American Rights Fund to join and endorse the				
26		name of the Papago Tribe on its amicus curiae brief to be filed in				
27		the case of United States v. Akin.				
28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council and					
29		William E. Strickland, the attorney of the Papago Tribe, are hereby				
30		authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect				
31	,	to this Resolution.				
32	The fore	arcing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 25th				

day of July, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c) (f) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
