RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 56-75

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Committee Board of Directors is now serious of  
2 contracting an Adult Education Program from the Bureau of Indian  
3 Affairs for the purpose of training and up-grading the individual  
4 Papago adult to be competitive in the employment market; and

5 WHEREAS, the training program is designed to increase the basic skills of  
6 approximately three hundred (300) Papago individuals on the Papago  
7 Reservation which will enable them to take advantage of the new  
8 training and employment opportunities now becoming a reality on the  
9 Papago Reservation, especially in the mining industry, housing con-  
10 struction and farming.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council confirms and supports  
12 the Resolution concerning the Papago Education Committee Board of  
13 Directors' Adult Education Program.

14 The foregoing Resolution was adopted and approved on the 25th day of July, 1975,  
15 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for, 0 not  
16 voting, 0 against and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago  
17 Council by Section 2(a) (h) and (k) of Article V of the Constitution and By-  
18 laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936,  
19 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat; 984)  
20 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effect-  
21 ive as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency  
22 and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

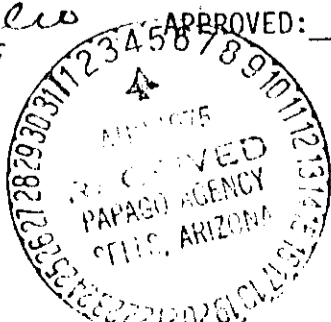
