

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RECEIVED AUG 05 1975

RES. NO. 58-75

1 WHEREAS, the 1975 CAP Public Hearing demonstrated that the Papago people do
2 believe that the CAP programs are of value and do wish that these
3 programs be continued and improved; and

4 WHEREAS, the Washington Office of Native American Programs has indicated that
5 they will refund the Papago Tribe in the amount of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-
6 SEVEN DOLLARS (\$357,000) which is the same amount as we have recieved
7 for the past three years; and

8 WHEREAS, due to the rising costs of gasoline, vehicles, materials and salaries,
9 the amount of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$357,000) is not
10 sufficient to continue the CAP programs at their current levels.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL THAT:

12 They do authorize Papago CAP to submit proposals for the continuation
13 next year of the Headstart, Legal Services and ONAP programs;

14 They do specify that the ONAP money shall be used to continue the
15 following programs:

- 16 -Community Deveopment
- 17 -CAP Administration, Planning & Accounting
- 18 -CAP Board & Special District Assistance Funds
- 19 -Purchase of Housing Materials
(Provided other funds are not found)
- 20 -Public Transportation
- 21 -Training of CAP & other Tribal Employees
- 22 -Technical & Financial Assistance to other
Tribal Programs & Administration
- 23 -Assist with Funding of the Papago Nutrition
Program

24 They do authorize the Chairman, the Papago CAP Board, Legal Service
25 Board, Headstart Parent Policy Council and the CAP Directors to pre-
26 pare and submit to Washington, budgets and work programs for such
27 funds as are needed to operate and improve these programs;

28 They do specify that particular attention in budgeting for ONAP shall
29 be given to:

- 30 -Increase to the transportation for CD to provide to
the villages;
- 31 -Adequate funds for Housing Materials
- 32 -Salary increased adequate to compensate staff for in-
creased living costs;

33 They do request that the Washington ONAP Legal Services and Headstart
34 Offices recognize the need for increased funds due to the increase

1 in operating costs and to the increased Papago population and exercise
2 every effort to provide the additional funding required.

3 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 25th day
4 of July, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0
5 for, 0 against, 0 not voting and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested
6 in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) and Section 3 (h) of Article V
7 of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on
8 December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,
9 1937 (48 Stat: 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said
10 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of
11 the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
