13	Chairman and his delegates to negotiate with the B.I.A.						
14	to obtain said facility.						
15	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on						
16	the 25th day of July, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was						
17	present with a vote of 834.0 for, 0 against, 0 not voting,						
18	and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council						
19	by Section 2(d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the						
20	Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936,						
21	and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937						
22	(Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.						
23	Said Resolution is effective upon passage by the Papago Council						
24	and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
