

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 60-75

1 WHEREAS, the production of the well located near Vaiva Vo, Arizona
2 Sif Oidak District, Papago Reservation, has become insuf-
3 ficient to supply said Village with water to meet the
4 inhabitants needs; and

5 WHEREAS, a request was submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs
6 that this well be reconditioned if possible, or a new well
7 drilled and installed with the proper equipment, or if
8 feasible a pipe line from the existing irrigation well
9 located approximately 1 1/4 miles from said village; and

10 WHEREAS, the Public Health Service (Indian Health Service) indica-
11 ted that they would provide sufficient water for the vil-
12 lage by one of the methods set forth hereinabove provided
13 the Sif Oidak District would pay one-third (1/3) of the
14 cost thereof; and

15 WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Public Health Service (Indian
16 Health Service) be prepaid by the District for the cost
17 of providing the village of Vaiva Vo with a adequate
18 water supply; and

19 WHEREAS, on April 1, 1975, the Sif Oidak District Council passed
20 a resolution agreeing to pay one-third (1/3) of the cost
21 of providing an adequate water supply to the residents of
22 the village of Vaiva Vo provided that the said sum does
23 not exceed TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) and that the
24 sum of \$10,000 be paid immediately to the Public Health
25 Service (Indian Health Service) with an agreement from
26 and all sums exceeding one-third (1/3) of the cost of
27 providing an adequate water supply to the village of
28 Vaiva Vo be immediately reimbursed to Sif Oidak District
29 through the Papago Tribal Utility Authority; and

30 WHEREAS, due to the emergency of the problem involved the sum of
31 \$10,000 has been paid to the Public Health Service (Indian
32 Health Service) for the purpose set forth hereinabove;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council rat-
2 ifies the payment by Sif Oidak District of \$10,000.00 to
3 the Public Health Service (Indian Health Service) with the
4 agreement that any and all sums exceeding one-third (1/3)
5 of the cost of providing an adequate water supply to the
6 village of Viava Vo be immediately reimbursed to Sif Oidak
7 District through the Papago Tribal Utility Authority.
8 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
9 the 25th day of July, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was pre-
10 sent with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and
11 0 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by
12 Section 2 (a) (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of
13 the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on Decmeber 12,
14 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,
15 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said
16 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the
17 Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review
18 by the Secretary of the Interior.
