RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 61-75

1 WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior, by his proposed Order on  
2 allocation of Central Arizona Project Water to the Papago  
3 Indian Reservation, as well as to the other four Central  
4 Arizona tribes, is threatening the economic stability of  
5 our reservation and the other four Central Arizona re-  
6 servations; and  
7 WHEREAS, the five Central Arizona tribes involved in the Central  
8 Arizona Project allocation of water have agreed to divide  
9 and allocate between the parties included all of the ex-  
10 penses, including attorneys' fees, et cetera, which may  
11 be necessary to effectively resist the proposed alloca-  
12 tion; and  
13 WHEREAS, said final agreement varies somewhat from the agreement  
14 approved and authorized for execution by Resolution No.  
15 34-75;  
16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it ap-  
17 proves the Agreement between the five tribes and the  
18 attorneys as per copy attached, and the Chairman and  
19 Secretary of the Papago Council are authorized to exe-  
20 cute said Agreement for and on behalf of the Papago Tribe.  
21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
22 the 25th day of July, 1975; at a meeting at which a quorum was  
23 present with a vote of 793.5 for; 0 against; 40.5 not voting and  
24 0 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by  
25 Section 2(a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws  
26 of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December  
27 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January  
28 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said  
29 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Super-  
30 intendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the  
31 Secretary of the Interior.
