RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 63-75

WHEREAS, the Papago Constitution provides that each District shall, through its District Council, govern itself and manage its local affairs, including the preparation and adoption of District budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Constitution impresses upon the Papago Council the obligation of controlling all Tribal funds not under the control of Congress, and of recommending appropriation of Tribal and other funds within the control of Congress or of the Secretary of Interior; and

WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Council has prepared and adopted a District budget for the forthcoming fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed said budget and finds it in every respect just and proper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the budget of the Chukut Kuk District, as prepared and adopted by its District Council and as attached hereto, is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 16th day of September, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 768.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
