2		rights, and in United States v. Cappaert (U.S. Court of Appeals, Ninth
3		Circuit, Cause No. 74-2186) (2) that the principles of the Winters
4		doctrine apply not only to surface waters of a river, but to ground
5		water as well, and (3) that the McCarren Amendment (43 U.S.C. Sec.666)
6		has not granted to States and State Courts jurisdiction over, and has
7		waived the sovereign immunity of the United States so as to allow them
8		to adjudicate the rights to the use of Reservation waters; and
9	WHEREAS,	the defendants in United States v. Cappaert are appealing that Court's

21	WHEREAS,	a reversal of such opinion would seriously and adversely affect the
