

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 72-75

1 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District of the Papago Reservation is faced with severe
2 water shortages and problems which have led the United States Govern-
3 ment, in its own right and on behalf of the Papago Tribe, and the
4 Papago Tribe to seek a declaration of rights to the use of, and damages
5 resulting from other persons' use of surface and ground waters of the
6 Upper Santa Cruz River Basin, including the Santa Cruz River and its
7 tributories within said basin, in Civil Causes No. 75-39 TUC., and
8 75-51 TUC., respectively, of the United States District Court for the
9 District of Arizona; and

10 WHEREAS, for the purpose of such suits and for the purpose of developing a water
11 resource management program for the San Xavier District it is important
12 that the Tribe obtain an accurate description and modeling of the hydro-
13 logic system of the San Xavier District and its environs, and that the
14 Tribe establish communications and a working relationship with the
15 technical faculty of the University of Arizona concerning water-related
16 problems on the San Xavier District and the Papago Reservation general-
17 ly; and

18 WHEREAS, the Department of Hydrology and Water Resources of the College of Earth
19 Science of the University of Arizona has prepared a Water Research Pro-
20 posal if accepted, (1) would develop lines of communication and a
21 working relationship between the Papago Tribe and the technical faculty,
22 of the University of Arizona concerning water-related problems on the
23 Papago Reservation, and (2) would develop research materials necessary
24 for the construction of a digital computer model of the hydraulic prop-
25 erties of that portion of the Tucson Basin Aquifer that is occupied by
26 the San Xavier District of the Papago Reservation which would (a) pro-
27 vide quantitative estimates of the effect of past and present pumping
28 in the Tucson Basin on water levels at the San Xavier District, and (b)
29 provide quantitative estimates of the effects of projected pumping (at
30 specific locations) on future water levels at the San Xavier District;
31 and

32 WHEREAS, the results of the research contemplated by the aforementioned research

1 Proposal would be of significant benefit to the San Xavier District and
2 its people and to the Papago Tribe.


3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it supports the Water
4 Resources Research Proposal, Title II, prepared by the Department of
5 Hydrology and Water Resources, College of Earth Sciences, at the
6 University of Arizona, for submission to the Office of Water Research
7 and Technology, U. S. Department of Interior, and that it hereby
8 authorizes and directs Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council,
9 on behalf of the Papago Tribe to perform all acts necessary to help
10 develop and implement said Proposal and to give effect to this Resolution.


11 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day
12 of October, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
13 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant
14 to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (c) of Article V
15 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the
16 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
17 January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said
18 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of
19 the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
