

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 73-75

1 WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District Youth and Adult Program of the Sif-Oidak Dis-  
2 trict is named defendant in a suit filed in the United States District  
3 Court of Arizona, (CIV 75-548 PHX) by Michael Leon Spaulding, a minor,  
4 et al., against the Estate of Roger A. Enos, deceased, et al., alleg-  
5 ing that Roger A. Enos was acting in the course and scope of his  
6 employment with the Sif-Oidak Youth and Adult Development Program on  
7 or about August 27, 1974, and at the time his motor vehicle collided  
8 with that of the plaintiffs, causing damages to the plaintiffs in an  
9 amount in excess of Six Million Dollars as prayed for in the Complaint;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS, there appears to be no conflict of interest and it would be to the  
12 benefit of the Papago Tribe if the Sif-Oidak District Youth and Adult  
13 Program were represented by the United States Attorney in the defense  
14 of said action.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request  
16 the United States Attorney to represent the Sif-Oidak District Youth  
17 and Adult Program of the Sif-Oidak District in all legal proceedings  
18 involved in connection with Civil Cause of Action No. 75-548 PHX. on  
19 file in the United States District Court of Arizona, and does hereby  
20 authorize Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council, to execute  
21 any and all consents or other instruments necessary for substitution  
22 of counsel, or otherwise, in order to facilitate the purposes of this  
23 Resolution.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 23rd day  
25 of September, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
26 730.0 for; 0 against; 2 not voting; and 2 absent; pursuant  
27 to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) (b) and (m) of Arti-  
28 cle V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified  
29 by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior  
30 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said  
31 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of  
32 the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
