

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 74-75

1 WHEREAS, the Plan of Operation of the Papago Tribal Utility Authority provides  
2 for a Management Board consisting of seven persons, at least three of  
3 whom shall be members of the Papago Tribe; and

4 WHEREAS, the present term of office of John T. McGue ended on June 30, 1975,  
5 and it is the recommendation of the other members of the Management  
6 Board to the Papago Council that he be re-appointed to a three year  
7 term as a Director; and

8 WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Papago Council has traditionally been a member of  
9 the Management Board and it is the recommendation of a majority of the  
10 Management Board that it is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe  
11 that Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council replace the former  
12 Chairman, Jacob A. Escalante, as a member of the Management Board and  
13 serve out the term of the former Chairman; and

14 WHEREAS, Frank Pablo, a member of the Management Board died on or about April  
15 24, 1975, and it is necessary that a new member be appointed as a  
16 director to fill this vacancy for a term of three years.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the following appoint-  
18 ments to the Management Board of the Papago Tribal Utility Authority  
19 be made:

- 20 1. John T. McGue, for a three year term ending June 30, 1978, and
- 21 2. Cecil Williams, for the remainder of the term of the former  
22 Chairman, Jacob A. Escalante, and
- 23 3. Larry Garcia, for a three year term ending June 30, 1978.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 23rd day  
25 of September, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
26 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant  
27 to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) of Article V of the  
28 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe  
29 on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January  
30 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said  
31 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of  
32 the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
