

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 86-75

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has obtained a revolving line of credit for a maximum
2 of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00) with the
3 Southern Arizona Bank and Trust Company for the interim financing of
4 construction of a Livestock Handling Complex at Sells Arizona, to be
5 constructed under a grant awarded to the Papago Tribe on January 26,
6 1973, by the Economic Development Administration (E.D.A.); and
7 WHEREAS, it is necessary to continue such interim financing to complete
8 construction of the Papago Livestock Complex.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Cecil Williams and Max Norris, the Chairman
10 and Vice-Chairman respectively, of the Papago Council, are hereby autho-
11 rized and directed to execute and deliver to the Southern Arizona Bank
12 and Trust Company any and all documents necessary to borrow up to ONE
13 HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00) from the Southern
14 Arizona Bank and Trust Company to continue the interim financing of
15 construction of the Livestock Handling Complex to be constructed
16 under E.D.A. grant.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7
18 day of November, 1975, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 834.0 for: 0 against: 0 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to
20 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) and Section 3 (a) of Art-
21 icle V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified
22 by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
23 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said
24 resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of
25 the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
