

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 15-77

1 WHEREAS, the Executive Health Staff of the Papago Tribe did present  
2 its budget for the period starting October 1, 1976 through  
3 September 30, 1977 and its various Programs, including:

4 Community Health Representatives  
5 Executive Health Staff  
6 Alcoholism  
7 Mental Health  
8 Papago Children's Home  
9 Nutrition  
10 Disease Control  
11 Elderly  
12 Highway Safety; and

13 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did consider said budget and believes  
14 that it will effectively standardize E.H.S. salaries and  
15 will efficiently manage Tribal health resources.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the attached budget of the  
17 Executive Health Staff and of each of its Programs is here-  
18 by approved, effective February 28, 1977.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
20 the 22nd day of February, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
21 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2  
22 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section  
23 2 (a) (d) and (f) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitu-  
24 tion and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the  
25 Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of  
26 the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
27 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
28 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the  
29 date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
