

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 16-77

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 13-77 appoint an
2 Election Board to supervise the 1977 general election sched-
3 uled for May 28, 1977; and

4 WHEREAS, the Election Board has submitted a budget to cover its anti-
5 cipated expenses for the general election and has recommended
6 that, like in the last general election, only the traditional
7 color-coded ballots and posters be used in this election.


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the members
9 of the Papago Election Board and the members of the District
10 Election Boards (appointed by the Papago Election Board in
11 accordance with Article V, Section 3 D, of the Uniform Elec-
12 tion Ordinance) shall be entitled to receive, upon presenta-
13 tion of proper vouchers, a per diem payment of \$25.00 per
14 day or portions thereof they attend Board meetings, plus
15 \$.12 per mile travelled to Board meetings or while on Board
16 business.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached budget of the Papago Election
18 Board is hereby approved; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the general election scheduled for
20 May 28, 1977, the ballot requirements of the Uniform Elec-
21 tion Ordinance are waived; that the traditional color-coded
22 ballots and posters be used; that the District Election
23 Boards of the various Districts are charged with completing
24 the color-coded ballots by marking the names of Villages
25 and District on the top of each ballot given to each pros-
26 pective voter, and by marking thereon the number of candi-
27 dates each voter is permitted to vote for upon such ballot;
28 and that the District Election Boards are further charged
29 with completing and posting the traditional color-coded
30 election posters in such a way that each voter can make easy
31 reference to such posters showing the names of the District
32 and Village Council to which the candidates are seeking

1 election, and the names and pictures (if they are provided
2 by the candidates) of the candidates.
3 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
4 the 4th day of March, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present
5 with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pur-
6 suant to the authority vested in the Council by Section (e) and (f)
7 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as
8 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
9 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pur-
10 suant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
11 Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and
12 is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
