

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 22-77


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Housing Authority and the Department of Housing and Urban
2 Development have entered into an Annual Contribution Contract for forty-
3 five (45) Mutual Help Housing Units known as Project AZ. 26-9; and
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council and the Papago Housing Authority have executed
5 leases on the sites; and
6 WHEREAS, there have been changes in participants, owing to length of processing
7 time.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the leases be
9 amended as follows:


- 10 1. Lot No. 6; name on lease be changed from Rosita Juan
11 to Margaret Ruth Mattias.
- 12 2. Lot No. 9; name on lease be changed from Veronica Xavier
13 to Veronica Siquieros.
- 14 3. Omit Anthony Chico from the lease.
- 15 4. Lot No. 2; name on lease be changed from Juan Francisco
16 to Angelita Francisco.
- 17 5. Lot No. 1; lease description shall be changed to new
18 description. (Exhibit A)
- 19 6. Lot No. 13; add Ramon Antone to lease and add descrip-
tion of site. (Exhibit B)
- 20 7. Lot No. 5; unassigned lease shall be assigned to Rosita
Martinez.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th day of
22 March, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 802.0 for;
23 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the
24 Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of
25 the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
26 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
27 Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective
as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
