

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 26-77

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Utility Authority (PTUA) was created by Tribal Resolu-
2 tion No. 8-70, which adopted a Plan of Operation setting forth its pur-
3 poses, authority and management; and

4 WHEREAS, Section 20 of the Plan of Operation provides that the fiscal year of PTUA
5 shall be from July 1 to June 30; and


6 WHEREAS, now that PTUA is in full operation all Rural Electrification Administration
7 and other federal reports must be prepared for, and submitted each calen-
8 dar year; and

9 WHEREAS, the PTUA Management Board did by Resolution No. 77-3, dated January 20,
10 1977, request that its fiscal year be changed from the current period end-
11 ing December 31.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Plan of Operation of
13 the Papago Tribal Utility Authority is hereby amended by deleting the last
14 phrase of Section 20 and substituting therefor the following: "The fiscal
15 year of the Authority shall be from January 1 to December 31".

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day of
17 April, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for;
18 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to authority
19 vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws
20 of the Papago Tribe, as amended, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
ment by the Papago Council.
