

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 27-77

1 WHEREAS, by Resolution 60-73, the Papago Council did consent to the grant of a  
2 right-of-way across the Papago Reservation to Tucson Gas & Electric Com-  
3 pany (TG&E) upon certain terms and conditions to be evidenced by an agree-  
4 ment between TG&E and the Papago Tribal Utility Authority (PTUA) which  
5 had been charged by the Papago Council to negotiate such agreement and  
6 right-of-way for the Papago Tribe; and  
7 WHEREAS, PTUA did on June 25, 1974, enter into such agreement with TG&E on behalf  
8 of the Papago Tribe, and the Chairman of the Papago Council did simulta-  
9 neously therewith execute a Consent to Grant of Easement on behalf of the  
10 Papago Tribe; and  
11 WHEREAS, such Consent to Grant Easement provided for the construction of two 345  
12 KV transmission lines on such right-of-way, provided (in paragraph 5)  
13 that TG&E could in the future increase the voltage of the second trans-  
14 mission line to 500 KV, provided that such change did not materially alter  
15 the environment and that approval for such change was received from the  
16 Tribe and appropriate governmental authorities; and  
17 WHEREAS, TG&E did by letter dated December 21, 1976, to Mr. N. B. Bennett, Jr.,  
18 Chairman of PTUA's Management Board, request the Tribe's approval to  
19 change the voltage of the second line to be built on that portion of the  
20 right-of-way described in a legal description (PARCEL, PL 37, PINAL COUNTY)  
21 attached hereto, from 345 KV to 500 KV; and  
22 WHEREAS, PTUA did review such request and, finding that the change in voltage will  
23 not materially alter the environment or affect the original right-of-way  
24 grant, did by Resolution No. 77-2 recommend that the Papago Council  
25 approve such request; and  
26 WHEREAS, it appears that TG&E has obtained the necessary approval from the other  
27 appropriate governmental authorities for such requested increase in  
28 voltage.  
29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby grant  
30 approval to Tucson Gas & Electric Company, as required by Section 5 of  
31 the Consent to Grant of Easement dated June 25, 1974, to increase the  
32 voltage of its second transmission line from 345 KV to 500 KV over that

1 portion of its original right-of-way described in the attached legal  
2 description (PARCEL, PL-37, PAVNAL COUNTY).

3 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day of  
4 April, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 301.0 for  
5 0 against; 33.0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority  
6 vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) (c) and 3 (h) of Article V of the constitu-  
7 tion and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on  
8 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
9 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution  
10 is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago  
11 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
