13		- Study, evaluation and preparation of detailed recommen-

15		planning and management system.				
16		- Continued study and improvement of the present Tribal

18		- Study and planning of the construction and maintenance				
19		of domestic water and sanitation systems.				
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize and					
21	<u> </u>	request a grant from the Indian Health Service of the Department of				
22		Health, Education and Welfare.				
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it does authorize the use of said grant funds in the

25		- Study and improvement of the Tribal accounting system.

determined by the Chairman and Treasurer in consultation with the Executive Health and other staff and within the total amount of money available from I.H.S.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Cecil Williams, Chairman; or in his absence, Mr.

Max H. Norris, Vice Chairman; or Mr. Vincent Crawford, Treasurer, are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the necessary grant documents and any supplements, amendments or revisions thereto and to administer such grant for the duration of the grant.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 26th day of May, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 704.5 for: 66.0 against; 63.5 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
