

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 3-77

- 1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has received Economic Development Adminis-
2 tration funding for, and does plan to construct within the
3 immediate future, a Tribal Government Complex; and
4 WHEREAS, said construction will require a work force of forty (40)
5 to fifty (50) men and a payroll of at least \$300,000; and
6 WHEREAS, the Tribe does desire to retain as much of this payroll as
7 possible on the Reservation for the benefit of its own
8 people; and
9 WHEREAS, the Tribe does have a Construction Department which they
10 have deliberately staffed and equipped to perform all levels
11 of construction needed on the Reservation; and
12 WHEREAS, said Department has a crew of forty (40) trained men, 90%
13 of whom are Papago, has a fully experienced general manager,
14 and has successfully completed five other E.D.A. projects
15 and a number of major commercial projects; and
16 WHEREAS, the Department has successfully met certain preconditions
17 for consideration as verbally stated by E.D.A. representa-
18 tives, to wit the successfully completion, ahead of schedule
19 of the San Lucy Community Building; and
20 WHEREAS, E.D.A. regulations do permit Tribal construction of this
21 project via the force account procedure and said procedure
22 will result in improved coordination and the greatest
23 benefit to the Papago people.
24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
25 request the Economic Development Administration to ^{negotiate} authorize
26 construction of the Tribal Government Complex by the Papago
27 Construction Department under the force account procedure.
28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it does authorize the Chairman to make
29 all necessary formal applications to E.D.A. concerning this
30 request, and to negotiate and execute all necessary agree-
31 ments in accordance with this request.

Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
