

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 37-77

1 WHEREAS, the Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEPI) has been successfully adminis-  
2 tered during the past year; and

3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on May 25, 1977 review and approve the proposed  
4 budget for the TWEPI Program; and

5 WHEREAS, it is to the mutual benefit of the Papago people and the Bureau of Indian  
6 Affairs to continue the existing contract for Tribal Work Experience  
7 Program services.


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request a contract with  
9 the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct the Tribal Work Experience Service  
10 Program in accordance with the staffing and funding request enclosed with  
11 the Tribe's P.L. 93-638 contract application.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council, or in  
13 his absence Max H. Norris, Vice Chairman, or Vincent L. Crawford, Treasurer  
14 is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract or amendments  
15 thereto for the duration of the contract.


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said contract shall begin on October 1, 1977 and end  
17 September 30, 1978.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 26th day of  
19 May, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for;  
20 0 against; 0 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority  
21 vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws  
22 of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,  
and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section  
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-  
ment by the Papago Council.
