## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, it is sometimes necessary that employees of the Papago Tribe operate

U. S. Government vehicles in the course of, and as part of their employment by the Papago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Bureau of Indian Affairs regulations require that prior, and as a condition precedent to the operation of U. S. Government vehicles any operator of such vehicles be issued a SF-46 U. S. Government Motor Vehicle Operator's Identification Card; and

WHEREAS, before the Bureau of Indian Affairs can issue an SF-46 U. S. Government Motor Vehicle Operator's Identification Card it is necessary that the Papago Tribe consent to a limited waiver of its immunity from civil suit brought on account of accidents resulting from the operation of U. S. Government vehicles by Tribal employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby waives its immunity from civil suit for personal injury or property damage brought on account of any accident involving an employee of the Papago Tribe who at the time of the accident was holding a valid SF-46 U. S. Government Motor Vehicle Operator's Identification Card and was operating a U. S. Government vehicle in the course of his or her employment; provided, however, that this waiver shall only extend to the actual coverage and be limited by the liability limitations of the insurance policy currently in effect and carried by the Papago Tribe; and provided further (1) that prior to the issuance of a SF-46 U. S. Government Motor Vehicle Operator s Identification Card to any employee of the Papago Tribe, the Bureau of Indian Affairs receive written confirmation from the Papago Director of the Highway Safety Program that such employee is not on a list of excluded persons of the insurance policy carried by the Papago Tribe; and (2) that upon notification by the Papago Director of the Highway Safety Program that an employee of the Papago Tribe has been placed on such list of excluded persons, the Bureau of Indian Affairs recall any SF-46 U. S. Government Motor Vehicle Operator's Identification Card issued to such employee and advise such employee's Department or Tribal Administration of such recall.

NO. 41-77 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 26th day of May, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for: 0 against; 0 not voting; 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) (c) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
