

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 47-77

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has adopted a fiscal year of July 1 through June 30; and

2 WHEREAS, the Federal Government and its Departments and Agencies have changed  
3 their fiscal year from July 1 through June 30, to October 1 through  
4 September 30; and


5 WHEREAS, many of the Papago Tribe's contracts and grants are and will be based  
6 upon such new fiscal year and it will be to the benefit of the Papago  
7 Tribe if its fiscal year will continue to coincide with that of the  
8 Federal Government, its Department and Agencies.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the fiscal year of the  
10 Papago Tribe shall henceforth run from October 1 through September 30 of  
11 each year.


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the unbudgeted quarter between July 1, 1977, and  
13 September 30, 1977, the Papago Council adopts a carryover budget or bud-  
14 gets of (1) 25% of existing annual budgets not including costs for  
15 capital equipment, plus (2) the unused portions in such budgets for  
16 capital equipment.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd day of  
18 June, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for;  
19 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority  
20 vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Consitution and By-laws  
21 of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,  
and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section  
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-  
ment by the Papago Council.
