

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 49-77

1 WHEREAS, Section 104 (a) of P. L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds for  
2 the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of Tribal Governments"; and

3 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$224,895 of FY-77 funds for  
4 such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its Tribal  
6 government and management.


7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the Bureau of  
8 Indian Affairs to grant funds to the Papago Tribe in the amount of at  
9 least \$224,895.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such funds shall be used for the development and  
11 improvement of Tribal government according to the budget and work program  
12 herein attached.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Cecil Williams, Chairman, or in his absence, Mr.  
14 Max Norris, Vice Chairman, or Mr. Vincent Crawford, Treasurer are hereby authorized  
15 to negotiate and sign whatever grant documents are required and, further, to nego-  
16 tiate and sign amendments and extensions to such grant.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st day of  
18 June, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1065.0 for;  
19 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the  
20 Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of  
21 the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December  
22 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant  
23 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not  
24 subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of  
25 its enactment by the Papago Council.
