


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 50-77

1 WHEREAS, ASARCO has operated the Silver Bell mine north of the Schuk Toak District
2 of the Papago Reservation for approximately twenty-five years; and
3 WHEREAS, ASARCO is interested in outlining an exploration target on Tribal lands
4 in the Schuk Toak District in the vicinity of its Silver Bell operation;
5 and
6 WHEREAS, ASARCO has presented a proposal for consideration by the Schuk Toak
7 District and the Papago Council that ASARCO be granted a non-exclusive
8 drilling Permit for geological information on tribal lands located in
9 Sections 2 through 11, Township 12 South, Range 7 East, Schuk Toak Dis-
10 trict, Papago Indian Reservation, as shown on a plat map outlining the
11 area (a copy of which is attached to this resolution), which Permit would
12 be on the following terms and conditions: (1) ASARCO may drill no more
13 than three holes; (2) all drilling information will be made available
14 to the Papago Tribe; (3) the term of the Permit will be twelve months;
15 (4) the Permit fee will be \$10,000.00, to be paid to the Papago Tribe
16 and to be divided equally between the Papago Tribe and the Schuk Toak
17 District; (5) ASARCO will comply with the requirements of all applicable
18 regulations of the Code of Federal Regulations; (6) ASARCO will rehabi-
19 litate all drill sites and plug all holes; and (7) Access will be gained
20 from existing roads and washes; and
21 WHEREAS, it is understood that there is no commitment on the part of the District
22 or the Tribe to grant ASARCO an Exclusive Prospecting Permit or Mineral
23 Lease as a result of such a Non-exclusive Drilling Permit; and
24 WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council has approved the proposal of ASARCO as
25 stated above and recommends that the Papago Tribe grant such permit.
26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe approves and consents to the
27 grant of a Non-exclusive Drilling Permit to ASARCO in accordance with the
28 terms and conditions hereinabove set forth.
29 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st day of
30 June, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 939.5 for;
31 0 against; 125.5 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested
32 in the Council by Section 3 (1) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of

1 the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,
2 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
3 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effec-
4 tive as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency
5 and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
