14	with a vote of786.0_for; _171.5_against; _107.5_not voting; and						
15	1 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by						
16	Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the						
17	Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936,						
18	and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pur-						
19	suant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said						
20	Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and						
21	is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
