

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


RES. NO. 56-77

1 WHEREAS, the Office of Native American Program (ONAP) in their letter  
2 dated May 4, 1977, has informed the Papago Tribe that it  
3 does intend to fund the Papago Tribe for \$357,000; and  
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have a local ONAP funded program,  
5 Community Action Program (CAP); and  
6 WHEREAS, the CAP does have as its board, one (1) representative from  
7 each of the eleven (11) districts, which is delegated and  
8 has the authority to review and approve the CAP plans and  
9 budget; and  
10 WHEREAS, the CAP Board has reviewed and have planned on the use of  
11 the proposed \$357,000 grant and feel that it will be to  
12 the best interest of the Papago people that it does apply  
13 for the funds.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does  
15 recognize the authority of the CAP Board to plan, approve  
16 and apply for the \$357,000 funds intended for the Papago  
17 Tribe.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
19 the 13th day of July, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present  
20 with a vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,  
21 pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a)  
22 and (d) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-  
23 laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on Decem-  
24 ber 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Janu-  
25 ary 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
26 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its  
27 approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject  
28 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


