

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 5-77

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona applied for and received a  
2 grant from the U. S. Economic Development Administration  
3 for the construction of a multi-purpose community building  
4 at San Lucy (Gila Bend) and other locations identified as  
5 E.D.A. Project No. 07-01-00496; and

6 WHEREAS, the construction of these buildings was awarded to the  
7 Papago Construction Company under a Force Account Agree-  
8 ment; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Construction Company has satisfactorily com-  
10 pleted the construction of a multi-purpose community build-  
11 ing at San Lucy (Gila Bend) which has been inspected and  
12 approved by the Papago Construction Company and the Project  
13 Architect, Joe Wong of Wong Associates, Scottsdale, Arizona.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council, by this  
15 Resolution, accepts the building as complete.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council extends its appre-  
17 ciation and gratitude to the Economic Development Adminis-  
18 tration for the grant that made the construction of this  
19 needed facility possible.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
21 the 7th day of January, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
22 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0  
23 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Sec-  
24 tion 2 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the  
25 Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936  
and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
pursuant to Section 12 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).  
Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the  
Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by  
the Secretary of the Interior.
