

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 59-77

1 WHEREAS, Substantial and persistent unemployment exists within the Papago Reserva-  
2 tion; and

3 WHEREAS, Indian economic development and employment will be effectively stimulated  
4 if the Papago Tribe can construct, operate and sublease an industrial  
5 building on the Industrial Park of the San Xavier District.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council:

7 1) That Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council, is hereby authorize  
8 and directed to execute a lease dated July 22, 1977, on behalf of the  
9 Papago Tribe with the Papago-Tucson Development Corporation to Lots 12  
10 and 13 of the San Xavier Industrial Park, for a term of twenty-five (25)  
11 years, (with option to renew for a like term), with rental payments of  
12 30% of gross receipts from sublessees, for the construction, operation  
13 and sublease of a 40,000 square foot industrial building to be known as  
14 the Papago Tribe Indian Business Opportunity Building, and to be financed  
15 by means of a grant from the Economic Development Administration of the  
16 U.S. Department of Commerce.

17 2) That the above named Chairman of the Papago Council is hereby authorized  
18 to execute and file an application on behalf of the Papago Tribe of Ariz.  
19 with the Economic Development Administration of the U.S. Department of  
20 Commerce for a grant to aid in financing the construction of a 40,000  
21 square foot industrial building on the San Xavier Industrial Park for  
22 the purpose of stimulating Indian economic development and employment to  
23 be known as the Papago Tribe Indian Business Opportunity Building.

24 3) That the above named Chairman of the Papago Council is hereby auth-  
25 orized and directed to furnish such information as the Economic Develop-  
26 ment Administration may reasonably request in connection with the applica-  
27 tion which is herein authorized to be filed, and further is authorized  
28 to accept any offer of grant which may be tendered by the Economic  
29 Development Administration of the U.S. Department of Commerce.

31 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd day  
32 of July, 1977 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of

1 967 for; 17.5 against; 80.5 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority  
2 vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution  
3 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December  
4 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pur-  
5 suant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) Said Resolution is  
6 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the  
7 date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
