WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona has a goal of creating jobs for Papagos living on the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, The Tribe has established a Construction Department to create such employment by doing the construction of new buildings and facilities on the reservation; and

WHEREAS, The Tribe is filing an application for a grant to aid in financing the construction of the Papago Tribe Indian Business Opportunity Building to be located on the San Xavier Industrial Park; and

WHEREAS, The Tribe requests authorization to construct this facility using inhouse employees on a force account basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe (1) guarantees successful and timely completion of the project to the satisfaction of E.D.A., (2) states it will promptly pay all amounts due, and (3) agrees to complete construction at a cost not greater than the approved construction item plus change orders as might be approved by E.D.A.

16 | The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd day of July, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 638.5 for; 152.0 against; 274.5 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
