

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 60-77

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe of Arizona has a goal of creating jobs for Papagos living
2 on the Reservation; and

3 WHEREAS, The Tribe has established a Construction Department to create such employ-
4 ment by doing the construction of new buildings and facilities on the
5 reservation; and

6 WHEREAS, The Tribe is filing an application for a grant to aid in financing the
7 construction of the Papago Tribe Indian Business Opportunity Building to
8 be located on the San Xavier Industrial Park; and

9 WHEREAS, The Tribe requests authorization to construct this facility using in-
10 house employees on a force account basis.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe (1) guarantees successful and timely
12 completion of the project to the satisfaction of E.D.A., (2) states it
13 will promptly pay all amounts due, and (3) agrees to complete construction
14 at a cost not greater than the approved construction item plus change
15 orders as might be approved by E.D.A.

16 The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd day
17 of July, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 638.5 for;
18 152.0 against; 274.5 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested
19 in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the constitution and By-Laws of
20 the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,
21 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
22 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) Said Resolution is not
23 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the
24 date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
